PUBLIC AND ORAL COMMUNICATION: (short synopsis of who spoke and what they shared)

1. Review of Purpose and Rules of School Site Council (SSC).

• The purpose and rules were reviewed in small groups and then discussed as a larger group.

2. SSC Bylaws.

 Dr. Weatherford proposes that all review notes on own time. With the approval of bylaws, we will vote electronically on the plan. Two big changes: 1) to vote electronically; 2) principal appoints replacement (vs. nomination).

3. Principal Updates

- Update on Title 1 Monies from Dr. Weatherford.
 - Have a balance of 45K that we would discuss and vote upon in SSC. 21K needs to be allocated for prof development.
 - Thus far, much of the 21k has gone to salaries for special education teachers.
 - SSC will vote on 10/12/17 to decide whether monies will go from targeted assistance to schoolwide programs.

5. Review of Site Plan.

- Dr. Weatherford leads and over and requests feedback, comments, questions on the 2017 data.
- Key points of discussion:
 - ELA scores down (for all subgroups).
 - Math scores went up 64% to 64.9% (for all subgroups).
 - 71.43% of students with disabilities did not meet ELA goals.
 - There was a positive growth in the area of student connectedness.
 - Highlights = % being a part of the school & % an adult on campus cares about me. Noted positive correlation between high % of latter & lower amount of depression (found at Torrey Pines High).
 - P.12 Growth area: attain a 2% gain in proficiency scores
 - P.13 How funding is currently being used
 - Actions/tasks that support the goal and looking at cost & funding source.
 - Focus = assessment of these plans/actions.
 - P. 16 Healthy Kids Survey
 - 6% feel there is not an adult who cares for them

- 18% feel not safe at school
- Plan: Homeroom & anti-bullying programs and restorative practices will be looked at
- It was shared that 10/10/17 will be deadline to submit comments, questions, feedback to Dr. Weatherford. Dr. Weatherford will then prepare an updated plan by 10/17/17.
